### **About the Client**

Quinn's Food Store is a small family run newsagent in Ardmore Co. Waterford.

Quinn's Food Store inquired about installing a Solar PV system and the team at 3 Counties Energy Agency coordinated the entire Better Energy Communities application for them, from the initial energy audit, procurement to warranty checks and all required paperwork.



## The Challenge

Quinn's Food Store was spending upwards of €902 a month on electricity alone. Refrigeration was a major drain on power in the shop.

## The Approach

The 3cea team had a look at the electricity consumption and current connection. Our team of experts proposed a refrigeration upgrade consisting of a reduction of the size of the fridge from 5m to 2.5m multideck with doors. This will help with the best use of the refrigeration hours along with the shop's high consumption hours.

The refrigeration upgrade has led to a reduction in electricity bills on the site.
